#### **Good Afternoon Board of Directors:**

I am a citizen and taxpayer. MARTA's suit for attorney fees is unreasonable and seeks to prevent me from exercising my constitutional right. No court or agreement can deprive a citizen of his constitutional rights. Your actions seek to harm me financially and personally and to enjoin me from exercising my constitutional rights without due process of law or hearing to prevent me from petitioning my government for a redress of grievances.

It seems to me if this case was so frivolous and without merit, then why would it have taken a law firm like Holland and Knight to defend it, and 3 attorneys assigned to the case on the government dime? It is even more egregious that I cannot sue any of the parties involved as a pro se litigant for frivolous defenses for attorney fees.

In the case on appeal before the Georgia Court of Appeals, I am seeking the enforcement of public duty and to enjoin illegal sales tax levy extension actions regarding the collection and spending of taxpayer funds beyond the authorized RTCAA contract expiration date consented to by voters in 1971.

As a party to the lawsuit I have a constitutional right to due process and to seek justice under the Georgia Civil Practice Act. There has been no hearing on the matter at hand or the merits regarding the extension of the sales tax levy and contract without a referendum beyond August 31, 2021.

The threats and intimidations are violations of the Georgia Bar professional conduct code, state law, and federal civil rights laws. I believe that I am being targeted because I am a pro se, African American, and because of my economic status. As a citizen, I have a right to access the courts and exercise and petition my government just like all other citizens of the United States.

I am greatly offended that MARTA threaten me with attorney fees for exercising my right to due process, equal protection under the law, my civil rights, and my constitutional rights as a taxpayer and citizen in Georgia and the United States of America.

All citizens have a right to expect those who practice law or hold an office of trust and who take an oath to faithfully follow the law. It is the right of all citizens to hold their government accountable within the provisions of the Constitution through a petition, and the use of the courts, and that is what I am doing.

I suggest that MARTA withdraw its threats and demands, otherwise I will take appropriate action and seek sanctions. I am open and ready for a real settlement discussion, not the big bad wolf approach. I will fight with every fiber of my being to exercise my rights as a citizen and taxpayer. I will fight the good fight and get into good trouble. I will not surrender my rights as a citizen.
